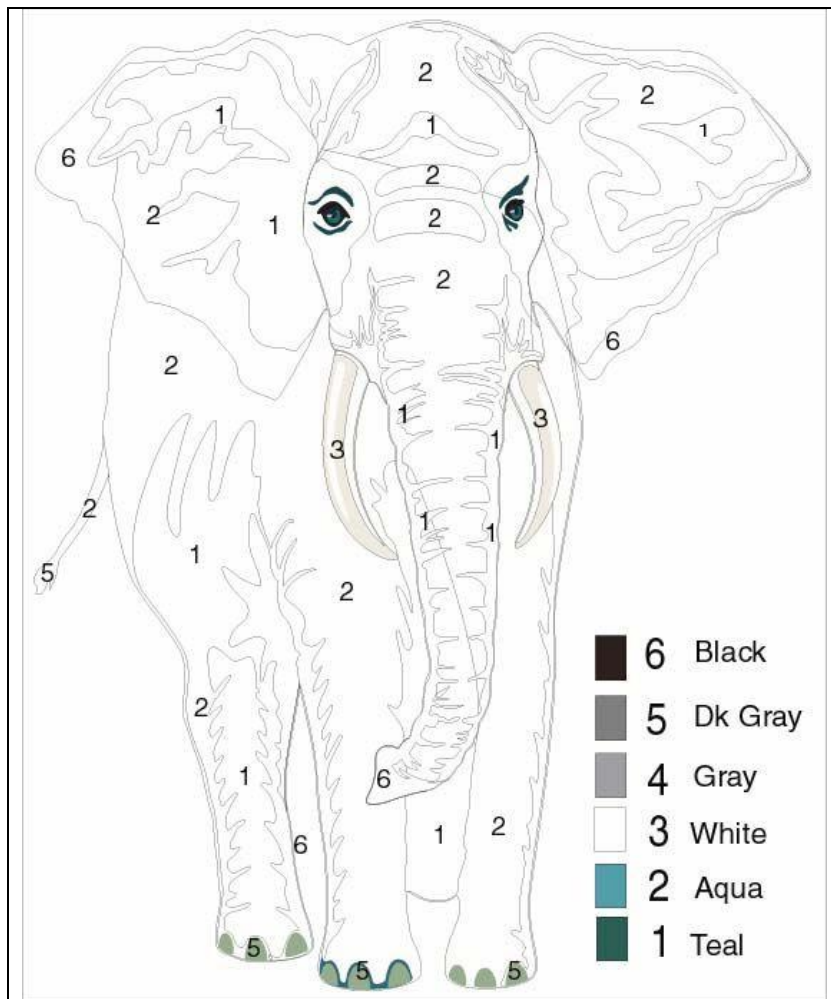




## Colour Pencil– Fun Colouring by Number

## **Colour Pencil– Fun Colouring by Number**

For this fun activity you will need to apply the skills I have taught you throughout our journey together.

### **Skills you will need for this project**

- You need to understand the importance of continuously looking at your subject matter.
- You will have to be creative and just do your best.

### **Tips**

- You will need to Match your colours to those of the picture before you start – if your colours don't match simply take the colour closest to the colour on the picture.

### **Skills you will learn from this exercise**

- One of the most important things for art students to learn is the concept of light and dark, and how these different values work to make up a picture. Paint by numbers highlights the light and dark areas with their numbering system and it makes a great study tool to figure out which parts go where.
- It will teach you to constantly refer back to your subject matter to make sure about what colours to use where which is highly beneficial for our art development and painting skills.
- You will also learn to have patience with art as art almost always requires us to be patient with the process and have fun while doing it.

# Steps for this Tutorial

## Step 1

Make sure you have all the supplies listed above ready and that you work on a flat surface.

## Step 2

Match your colours to those of the picture before you start – if your colours don't match simply take the colour closest to the colour on the picture.

## Step 3

Colour in all the 1's

Remember to make sure that you are using the correct colour for the number you are busy with.

## Step 4

Colour in all the 2's

Remember to make sure that you are using the correct colour for the number you are busy with.

## Step 5

Colour in all the 3's

Remember to make sure that you are using the correct colour for the number you are busy with.

## Step 6

Colour in all the 4's

Remember to make sure that you are using the correct colour for the number you are busy with.

### Step 7

Colour in all the 5's

Remember to make sure that you are using the correct colour for the number you are busy with.

### Step 8

Colour in all the 6's

Remember to make sure that you are using the correct colour for the number you are busy with.

### Step 9
